WEAD maintains an invaluable website (weadartists.org) that serves as a virtual gallery of artists' work, connects artists and curators with exhibition opportunities, and educates and enlightens through its groundbreaking WEAD Magazine.

Job Summary

We are seeking a talented WordPress Developer with strong PHP skills to complete specific improvements to our existing Wordpress site. The ideal candidate will have experience in developing, customizing, and maintaining WordPress websites and plugins including modifying theme and plugin php and javascript code. You will work closely with our web design committee to update our existing Wordpress site. This position allows for flexible hours and remote work. Applicants must be legally authorized to work in the United States, as we are unable to sponsor work visas.

Key Responsibilities

- Build upon WEAD's custom WordPress site, updating our custom theme and plugins using PHP, HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.
- Collaborate with the WEAD Web Committee to add core member functionality and convert UI/UX action items into functional WordPress code.
- Optimize website performance and ensure responsiveness across devices.
- Troubleshoot and resolve issues related to our WP Engine WordPress installation, custom theme, and related plugins.
- Implement, update, and manage website security measures.
- Stay up-to-date with the latest Wordpress best practices.

Specific Tasks

1. Replace existing Wordpress gallery image upload (NextGEN Gallery) used by 500+ active member-users with comparable, secure image upload integrated with existing profile system.

2. Identify and implement membership tracking plug-in for membership activity and payments.
3. Expand upload functionality to include form for image metadata - image title, dimensions, date, artists, media.
4. Implement various css/sass layout, alignment, and font fixes, with cross-browser and mobile testing.

- Proven experience as a WordPress Developer.
- Strong proficiency in PHP, MySQL, HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.
- Experience with cross-platform testing including mobile testing.
- Familiarity with WordPress best practices, themes, and plugin development.
- Excellent problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- Strong communication and teamwork abilities.
- Awareness and support for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion.
