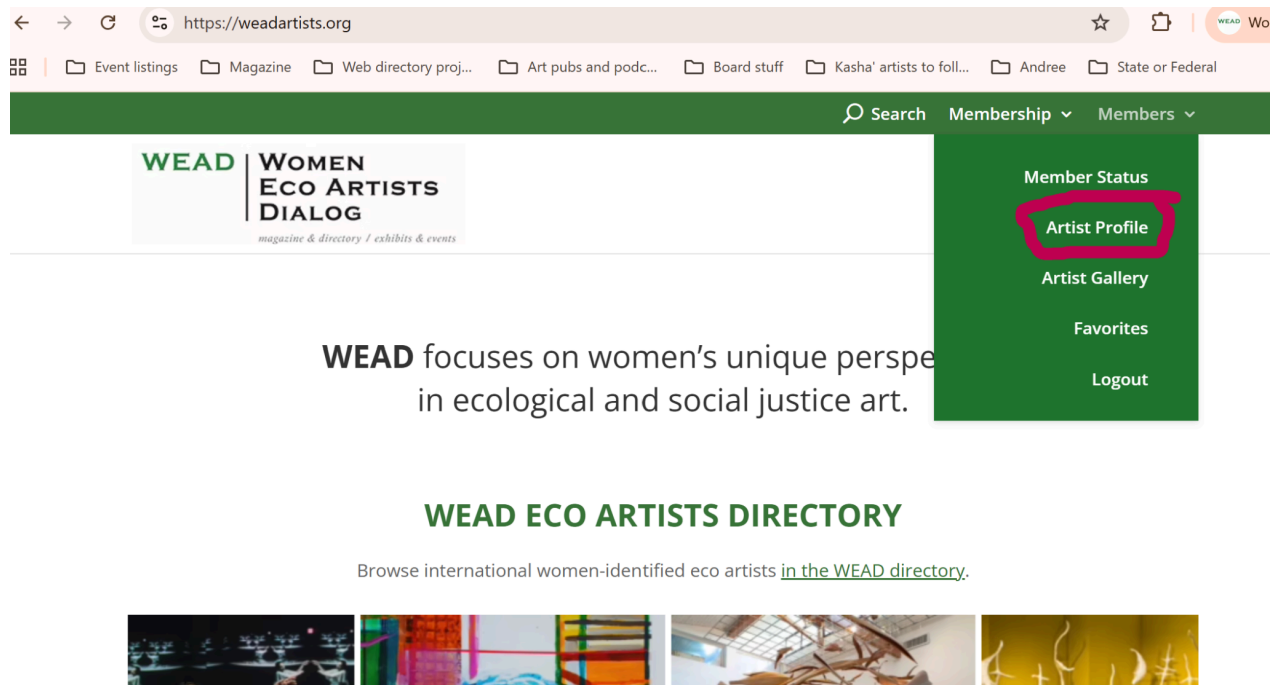


Step 1: To access and update your artist profile, click “**Members**” in the top right corner. Login. Then, select “**Artist Profile**” from the “Members” drop down selection.



Step 2: On the Artist Profile page, upload a “Profile image.” This image will sit next to your name when the people search the WEAD directory. This image will appear only as a thumbnail, so it's best to keep it simple. We recommend a headshot or a small detail from one of your pieces of art. We accept these file types: jpg, png, jpeg, The maximum file size is 1 MB for this image.

Step 3: On the Artist Profile page, complete your “Bio/Statement.” This section can be written in first person (e.g., “I am”) or third person (e.g., “she is”). We recommend that you include:

- The artistic mediums you work in
- A description of your artistic style or philosophy
- City where you are originally from
- Where you currently live
- Artistic influences
- Degrees or major courses of study, and with what institution you studied
- If you are self-taught, a brief description of your artistic explorations
- Recent or major exhibitions

After uploading your profile image and entering your “Bio/Statement,” be sure to scroll down to the bottom of the page and hit the green “Save” button.

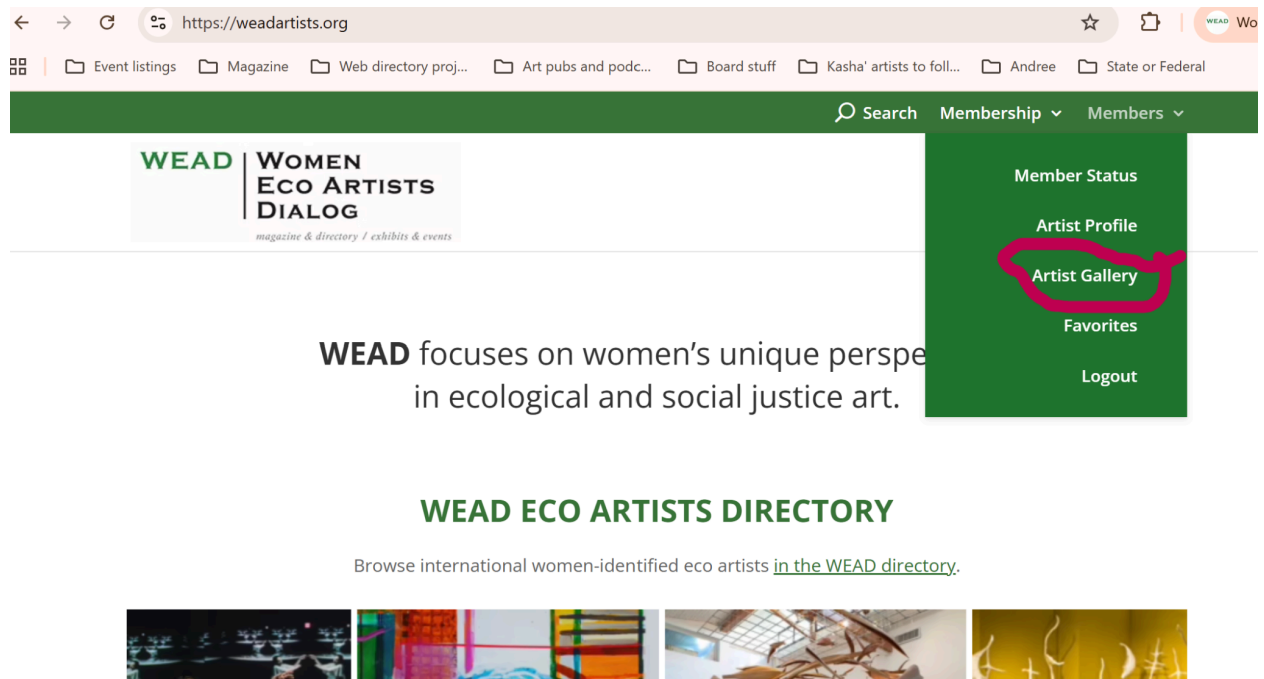
Step 6: If you would like to share your website and social media, enter them next.

Step 7: After saving your artist profile, go back to “Members” in the top right corner. Select “Artist Gallery” from the drop down selection.



Step 8: (Step 8 has several components, so there are 4 screenshots.)

You can add up to 15 images to your gallery. Images you have successfully uploaded will appear in the “Existing Gallery Images” section. Upload (or drag and drop) image files that you want to add to your gallery to “New Gallery Images.” We recommend that you:

- Upload one file. **The images will be displayed in the order that you upload them.** We can accept these file types: jpg, png, jpeg. The maximum size for each image file is 4 MB. We recommend 1-2 MB.
- Add a description for that file in the “Gallery Image Descriptions” section. **Please include the title of the piece, materials used, date, location, and photo credit.** Including these details will help researchers, galleries, and museums find and use your artwork effectively.
